

### **FREE H1N1 VACCINATIONS AVAILABLE WEDNESDAYS IN APRIL**

**Basking Ridge, NJ (April 5, 2010)** -- The Bernards Township Health Department will offer free H1N1 flu vaccinations on Wednesday afternoons from 4 to 5:30 at its headquarters at 262 South Finley Avenue in Basking Ridge. The dates are April 7, 14, 21 and 28. Appointments are requested by calling the Health Department at (908) 204-2520, but walk-ins are also welcome. "We are still encouraging people to get vaccinated as H1N1 did not hit until spring last year and lasted through the summer," said Health Office Lucy Forgione. "A vaccination is the single best protection against H1N1," she said.
